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

In the academic year of 2024/2025, the Group has 11 schools and early years centres in the network.









AISL HARROW INTERNATIONAL SCHOOLS



With over 20 years' experience operating in Asia, Harrow International Schools are a group of independent day and boarding schools providing British education for students aged 18 months to 18 years.

The age range is broad, as is the representation of nationalities. This international diversity creates a dynamic learning environment. Helping to shape the character of all students regardless of age and nationality are the Harrow School's Values of Courage, Honour, Humility and Fellowship. These Values anchor the holistic educational approach that focuses on individual care and support to develop the whole person. Our schools are equally renowned for academic excellence, the House System, and enrichment and service activities that produce high-achievers with the leadership attributes and experiences that will serve them well throughout their lives and benefit the wider community tomorrow.





Our Curriculum

Early Years (age 2 to 5)

Our Harrow Little Lions Curriculum (HLLC) is specifically designed for AISL Harrow Schools and draws from the very best examples and experiences of kindergarten curricula around the world. Children are able to develop creative thinking and essential life skills through an exciting, individualised curriculum that recognises that every child is unique. Children also benefit from lessons by specialists in Physical Education, Music, and Languages.

Pre-Prep Phase (age 5 to 10)

In Pre-Prep, children continue to develop essential literacy, numeracy and commuting skills. Emphasis is placed on the enjoyment of books and the teaching of reading and writing along with Mathematics and Coding. As they progress through Pre Prep, children are introduced to more specialist subjects in Languages, Music, Physical Education, Drama, Computing, Design Technology and Science.

Prep Phase (age 10 to 13)

Modelled on the best practices of British Preparatory Schools and international Middle Schools, our Prep Phase is a blend of specialist-taught core subjects such as English, Mandarin, Mathematics, Science and Coding, with additional subjects taught including: Art, Drama, Design Technology, Geography, History, Music and Physical Education.

The Senior Phase (age 13 to 16)

Designed to build on the knowledge and skills developed in the Prep Phase, our Senior School curriculum is increasingly academically demanding, focusing students on national and international public examinations.

Building towards their IGCSE examinations (usually taken in Year 11), students are intellectually stretched. Subjects taught include: Art, Biology, Chemistry, Computing, Design Technology, Drama, English, Geography, History, Languages, Mathematics, Physics and Physical Education.

The Sixth Form (age 16 to 18)

Following IGCSE examinations, students move into the 'Sixth Form' Phase of the School and prepare themselves for success at University. They complete a two-year suite of A-Level courses, that are regarded as the gold standard of the British education system and recognised worldwide for university entrance.

The Sixth Form years are both challenging and exciting. Students have the opportunity to specialise in subjects they particularly excel at and study these areas to an advanced academic level. Many students complete an 'Extended Project Qualification' (EPQ) which allows for the development of research skills and the exploration of a topic of special interest in even greater depth. Students also have an opportunity to contribute to the management and leadership of the school by taking on key student positions of responsibility such as Prefect, Senior Prefect, Head Girl, Head Boy, Student Academic Leadership Team and the Student Council.



AISL HARROW LIDE SCHOOLS




AISL Harrow LiDe Schools ('LiDe') offer Chinese families an internationalised education rooted in the Chinese National Curriculum. For students between 6 to 15 years of age, LiDe provides access to a compulsory education but adopting an educational philosophy designed to deliver (A) academic

excellence in international qualifications, (B) promote fluency in English language acquisition, (C) establish a Chinese identity that serves as a foundation on which to understand other cultures and (D) developing the students as learners, individuals and citizens. In high school, our students study IGCSE and then A Level alongside providing access to compulsory curriculum elements of Chinese, history, geography and politics and ideology. A LiDe education leads to access to world leading universities including Oxbridge and Ivy League.





The outcome (ABCD) of a Harrow LiDe education is founded on the 123 of education



1. Within the School Environment: Harrow LiDe Curriculum and Super Curriculum

Specifically designed for Chinese students, the Harrow LiDe Curriculum is a research-informed and cutting-edge pedagogical approach. A sophisticated and demanding approach to English language acquisition is adopted from the Early Years through to High School. This is weaved in a fluent manner with Putonghua. Through planned and purposeful immersion students can communicate and tackle problems by applying subject based cognition across the two languages.



The Harrow LiDe Super Curriculum enhances the LiDe Curriculum by providing extended learning opportunities. These courses, tailored to students' interests, enrich their learning experience, deepen their understanding of complex subjects, and offer personalised guidance on furthering their education and exploring career paths. By developing their skills and interests and unleashing their potential, we aim to cultivate lifelong learners among our students.

2. Out-of-classroom Learning

We believe vital learning takes place outside of the classroom. Our Co-curricular programmes broaden horizons, instil a sense of adventure, and foster the six leadership attributes. In keeping with our motto, Educational Excellence for Life and Leadership, every student is required to make a positive contribution to his or her community.



3. Pastoral Care System, House System and Boarding

Pastoral Care System

Pastoral care at Harrow LiDe is central to its vision and ethos. Pastoral care systems focus on the child as an individual, fully developing each student's values, identity and aptitudes. Pastoral care provision for younger pupils is provided by the class teachers. It comprises a proactive and positive approach to personal and social development along with personal guidance and support from the teacher. Older pupils are allocated to a House where the Housemaster or Housemistress (HM) and tutors will provide guidance, mentoring and coaching to support student development.

House System

A house system is central to Pastoral care provision through a team of pastoral leaders and tutors. Students benefit from mentoring and support from HMs and tutors, along with peer mentoring and coaching from older pupils. Older students will take on a leadership role and serve as role models. Through contributing to House events and competitions, students engender a sense of belonging and collegiality while building a bond with fellow students from multiple year groups. For Harrow LiDe students, the House is very much their home in school.

Harrow Boarding

Harrow Boarding aims to develop students' independence, self-regulation, confidence and interpersonal skills. Boarding offers extended learning opportunities, including supervised evening study hours and a range of additional sporting, academic, creative and wellbeing activities after school and on weekends. These sessions provide boarders with further opportunities to access the school's facilities, develop new and existing skills, support their mental health, and interact with peers from other Houses – all the while being continually supported by staff.

AISL Harrow Hong Kong Children School ('HHKCS') affords an AISL Harrow education to families with a connection to Hong Kong and the Greater Bay Area.

The educational offer is founded on the curriculum framework from Hong Kong and leads to a dual pathway of the Hong Kong Diploma in Secondary Education (DSE) or the IB Diploma. The model of delivery is synonymous with all AISL Harrow schools and founded on a holistic approach to developing the child at a personalised level through a broad and deep enrichment programme, structured pastoral care and a commitment to boarding.

AISL Harrow Little Lions ('HLL') provides an early years education to children between the age of 2 to 6 years. The AISL Harrow Little Lions philosophy and curriculum is specifically designed to prepare students for transition into a HIS, LiDe or HHKCS and lay the foundations for academic success.

Our Little Lions Curriculum is specifically designed for AISL Harrow Schools and draws from the very best examples and experiences of kindergarten curricula around the world. It specifically incorporates the core Harrow values of courage, humility, fellowship and honour. The curriculum specifically adheres to all relevant education regulations and guidelines, ensuring that it is mapped to meet necessary standards. Together with our unique pedagogical approach, we holistically cultivate children's creative thinking and teamwork ethic and ensure all younger learners achieve rounded and balanced personal development, applying what they learn to their daily lives.



Learning Domains and Learning Disciplines

Central to the curriculum are ten Learning Domains and five Learning Disciplines. The learning domains identify the core content that children will require in order to be appropriately informed, knowledgeable, and skilled. The domains ensure that children develop effectively and are able to contextualise and support lifelong learning in conjunction with the associated learning disciplines. The learning disciplines provide content for the essential learning behaviours that enable a perspective within which learning domains will be utilised and applied. This interface between disciplines and domains lies at the heart and aspiration for the AISL Harrow Early Years Curriculum and enables children to both support and develop lifelong learning behaviours as well as understand the nature and purpose of intellectual pursuit (Katz, 2015) and the potential for deep level learning (Saljo, 1979).

Students develop the strength of character to excel in a dynamically evolving world, preparing them for a high-achieving and successful futures.

OUR HOUSE SYSTEM

Modelled on the best practices of Harrow School in the UK, from Pre Prep Phase (age 5), every student belongs to a House. Each House has its own distinctive name, a House colour, House flags and House Mistress or Master.

The House offers students a smaller, closer community within the school, broadening the range of activities and support available. House events include: Sports Days, Charity Events, Dance and Music Competitions and various Sports Competitions. In these numerous activities, community pride finds expression in a healthy competitive spirit.

A key strength of the House system is the vertical integration of different aged pupils. This creates a 'family' unit within which responsibilities are assigned to older students to care for and support their younger peers.

The House system is the most distinctive characteristic of a Harrow-branded education and is central to the school's culture and success. The development of House communities is characterised by strong bonds and support networks within each House. The House Master or Mistress and Form Tutor knows each member of the House extremely well, allowing for close monitoring of academic performance as well as pastoral support. Therefore, if and when there is a problem the student will swiftly receive well judged, individualised and effective support to get back on track.

Being a Boarder is the most authentic way to experience our holistic education; after all, Harrow School in the UK has been offering a boarding-only education for many decades.


Boarders benefit from being part of a community, from learning to live alongside others, and from having world-class facilities right on their doorstep.

PERSONALISED SUPPORT, PASTORAL CARE




We recognise that every child is unique, with individual needs and requirements.




Harrow School in the UK is one of the world's most respected private educational institutions.


