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



The school officially opened in Nanning in 2020 and commenced full operations in September 2021. As a major educational initiative in Nanning, it is also the first globally recognised education brand to establish a presence in Guangxi.

The school occupies an area of 100 acres, with a total building area of 66,000 square metres. It has the capacity to accommodate 1,460 students and provides boarding services for over 260 students in G3 and above.

OUR CURRICULUM

Early Years

Our AISL Harrow Little Lions Curriculum (HLLC) is specifically designed for AISL Harrow Schools and draws from the very best examples and experiences of kindergarten curricula around the world. It specifically incorporates the core Harrow values of courage, humility, fellowship and honour, and adheres to the Guidelines on the Learning and Development of Children aged 3-6 issued by the Ministry of Education of China and other relevant regulations, ensuring that it is mapped to meet the standards. Together with our unique pedagogical approach, we holistically cultivate children's creative thinking and teamwork ethic and ensure all younger learners achieve rounded and balanced personal development, applying what they learn to their daily lives.

Central to the curriculum are ten Learning Domains and five Learning Disciplines. 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Grade 1 to Grade 9 (Age Six to Fourteen)

Our Harrow LiDe School curriculum for Grades 1 to Grade 9 is committed to ensuring excellence in delivery of the Chinese National Compulsory Education Curriculum, combining this with our unique approach to holistic education – preparing students to excel academically and to succeed as global citizens.

Exclusively designed by senior education experts, the curriculum blends the best of East and West. Core subjects such as History, Geography, Chinese Language, Calligraphy and Culture and Moral Education are taught in Chinese, using the rigour of Chinese teaching methodologies. Subjects such as Biology, Chemistry, English Language, ICT, Mathematics, and Physics, together with co-curricular Arts and Design, Physical Education and Music offer an opportunity for acquiring bilingualism through being delivered in English and supported in the Chinese.

Students transition to the sixth forms with confident in both Chinese and English, well prepared academically and socially for entry to the very best universities globally. This approach, a first in China, ensures that students benefit from a world-class education which blends academic excellence with preparation for life and leadership.



Grade 10 (Age Fifteen)

Students study a range of International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) courses. Highly regarded, IGCSE is an excellent and academically challenging preparation for A-level. The LiDe curriculum and bilingual approach ensures that they are well prepared for success academically but also to flourish personally, socially and emotionally.



Grade 11 - 12 (Age Sixteen to Seventeen)

In this phase of the school, students study a number of A-Level subjects. These courses are considered to be an academically rigorous preparation for university study. A bespoke university preparation programme guides pupils and parents towards preparation for applications for and transition to higher education. The focus on building a deep knowledge and appreciation of Chinese heritage, culture and language is maintained throughout sixth form. Students leave the school prepared for success and leadership in China and beyond.



Senior Phase and Sixth Forms

In the senior school, the curriculum is designed to prepare students for life at university and beyond. This includes access to rigorous international qualifications: A-Level, the gold standard internationally and recognise by leading universities across the world.










INTRODUCTION OF NANNING CITY



Nanning is the capital and largest city by population of the Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region in Southern China. It is known as the "Green City (绿城)" because of its abundance of lush subtropical foliage. Located in the South of Guangxi, Nanning is surrounded by a hilly basin, with a warm, monsoon-influenced humid subtropical climate.

Beginning in 1949, as it underwent sustained industrial growth, Nanning's economy began developing beyond its former role, and the city became essentially a commercial and administrative centre. Today, Nanning is considered the economic, financial and cultural center of Guangxi, and the chief centre for the training of the Zhuang minority in Guangxi. The People's Park is located in the center of the city. The city also serves as a gateway for the China-ASEAN opening up and cooperation.

Transportation

At first it may be more convenient to get around using Didi. Trips are charged at a flag fee of 8.5rmb with additional costs per kilometer. You can also buy a Nanning Citizen Card to pay for the bus, and Nanning City bike rentals. There is an office at Nanning East train station to buy it. Just bring your passport to register the card and place a deposit on it. When the amount on the card gets low, you can refill it at different locations around the city.


- Metro/Subway (地铁)- Starting from 2 rmb per trip up to 6 rmb. You can pay with cash at the ticket booth or with e-cash such as WeChat or Alipay.
- Bus (require cash/city transport app) 2 rmb per trip unless it's long distance. Long distance buses require a ticket before you board the bus.
- DiDi- Equivalent to Uber- It is in English and most locations can easily be found through a search as long as you have a street address. You can also pay cash for a Didi, but make sure to have the exact amount. You can also choose to pay directly through the app.



Weather

Nanning has a humid subtropical monsoon climate, with abundant sunshine, rainfall, little frost and no snow.

The climate is mild, with long summer and short winter. The annual average temperature is about 21.6 °C. The coldest January in winter is 12.8 °C on average, and the hottest July and August in summer is 28.2 °C. The climate is characterized by heat and humidity.
